Two important events coming up are Student and Kids camps. Dates for the Student Camp are June 6-10. This year the site is Camp Windermere in Missouri. Cost is \$200.00 per student. Dates for Kids Camp are June 23-26. The camp is held at Ponderosa Retreat and Conference Center at Larkspur, about 30 minutes from Colorado Springs. Cost \$150. per “camper.”

We continue to receive the Jimmy Wilhelm Offering for our students and children. We need to raise approximately \$10,000. Be sure to give generously in order that all students and children

who want to go to camp can attend. Your gift is a financial investment.

Continue to pray for our church as we seek property for future ministry. To date, we have \$1,245,049.21 in our Future Property Ministry Fund. Also, we have received \$122,627.36 in designated funds toward future property. Our new total is \$1,367,676.57. I praise GOD for the way He continues to provide miraculously for the exciting and awesome future He has for us. I can’t wait to see our great GOD continue to reveal His will for our future!

Prayer is a priority for our church family! We have GOD’S 100, a prayer ministry of over 120 members and attenders who pray for the ministry of Circle Drive on a daily basis. Our pastoral staff produces a monthly prayer guide for participants. They receive it in the mail. We also have the “Connecting with GOD” prayer meeting every Saturday form 9:00 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. We meet in our worship center, have a brief challenge from the Word GOD, then “fan out” all across our buildings and campus, praying for Sunday services, SS teachers/officers, and for the future ministry at Circle.

I am so grateful to GOD for allowing me the privilege of serving such a wonderful and visionary people. We are not content with “business as usual.” We continue to move forward by faith to His preferred future for our church’s ministry. I literally can’t wait to see GOD’s wonderful plan unfold for us in the days ahead!
